DECEMBER 2019 TREASURER'S REPORT

Total income for December, 2019 was \$37,196, the budget amount was \$42,000. Total expenses were \$34,306 compared with a budget amount of \$35,092. For the month, income exceeded expenses by \$2,890.

Income for the year ending December 31, 2019 was \$424,958, compared with the prior year of \$427,395. Expenses were \$402,062 in 2019, compared with the prior year of \$404,168.
